Inconnu Lodge is located one hundred and eighty miles east of Whitehorse in Canada's Yukon Territory. Situated on the north shore of McEvoy Lake, the lodge is forty miles west of the Northwest Territories – Yukon border and one hundred twenty five miles north of the British Columbia – Yukon border.

Activities

Inconnu Lodge offers it's clients some of the finest fishing in Canada's north. We utilize a variety of lakes and streams to give our guests a diverse fishing adventure. Each day guests, along with their guide, fly out via our Dehavilland Beaver. We fish for Lake Trout, Northern Pike, Arctic Grayling, Inconnu or Shee Fish and Bull Trout.

Your Journey To Reach Us

This ultimate destination is in the heart of the Yukon Territory, so you would begin your adventure by flying into Vancouver, British Columbia or Calgary Alberta. From there, hop on Air North, Air Canada or WestJet, nonstop to Whitehorse, Yukon Territory, Canada. The hotel we utilize provides a shuttle service to and from the airport. You will then spend an evening in Whitehorse and the following morning our representative will pick you up at the hotel for the flight out to Inconnu Lodge.

Not included in the package are flyout day trips to Virginia Falls on the South Nahanni River in the NWT via floatplane, fishing licenses, overnight stays in Whitehorse, items of a personal nature, bar and store tabs, gratuities (Customary is 10%) and applicable taxes. The Yukon has a 5% tax on all items.

A deposit of 25% is required to reserve your space. A further payment of 25% is due before December 15 and the balance due May 1.

Deposits can be made by Visa or MC, balance due would be by direct transfer.

Cancellations are non-refundable, but can be transferred to another date if notified by Mar 1 of the year the trip is to be taken. A 10% re-scheduling fee will be charged.
